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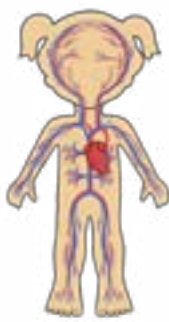

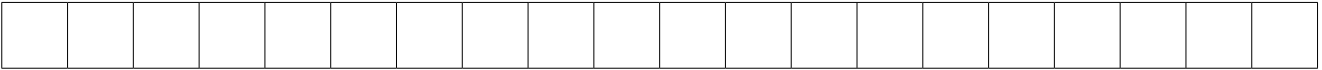

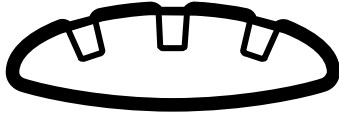

Bread consists of $\frac{1}{3}$ of water

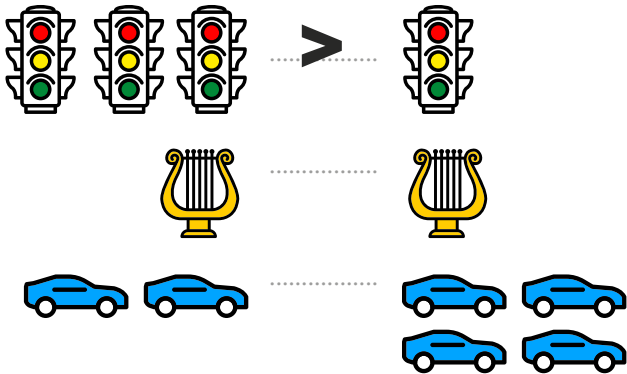


Our body consists of $\frac{2}{3}$ of water

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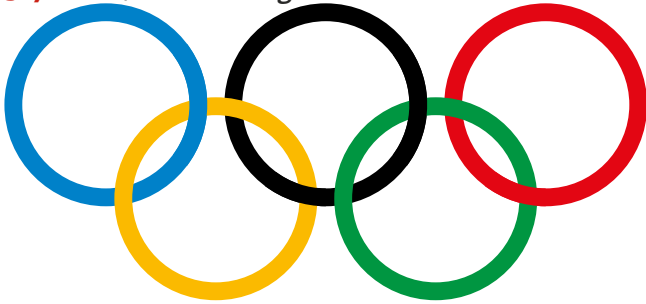

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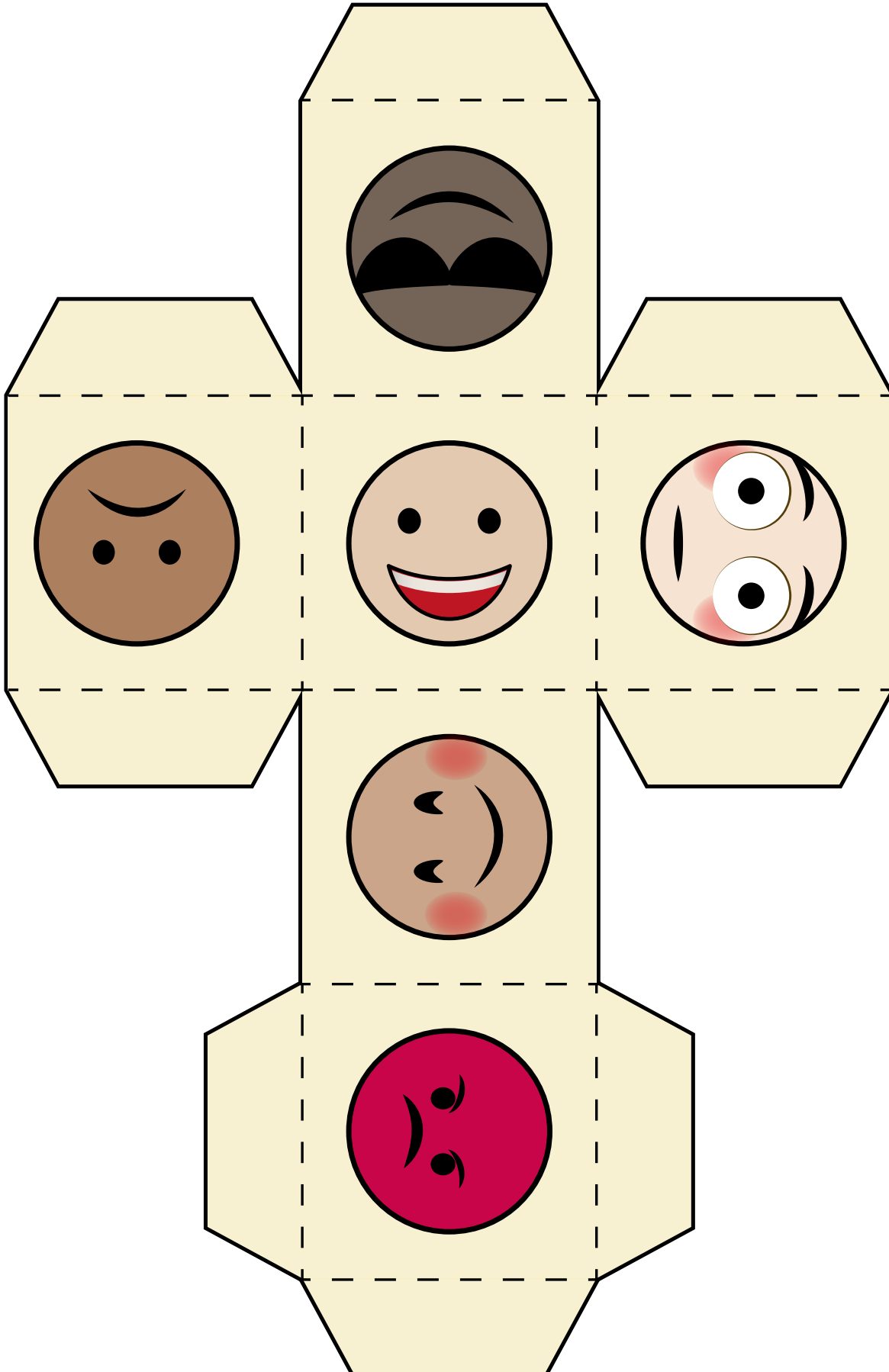
